

# Registration of Interest - Save Our Scarlet Robin Landholder Small Grants CLOSING DATE for Round 4: December 31, 2019

*Supporting local community action towards the recognition and protection of the Scarlet Robin and its' habitat.*

## About the funding

This funding program provides landholders within identified target areas (Braidwood, Burra, Delegate and Michelago areas) the opportunity to apply for financial and technical assistance to improve native habitat within their property, along with assistance to monitor positive impacts to landscape scale biodiversity, with eight identified threatened woodland birds the particular focus.

### Protection, Management and Expansion of Existing Remnant Native Vegetation:

Funding is available to protect woodland/ forest remnants that will create an area with a minimum size of 2 Ha. It is possible, and encouraged, that you work with your neighbours to expand the size of an existing remnant and reduce gaps between remnants within and between properties.

### Revegetation Activities

Funding is available with the aim of improving habitat connectivity across our landscape.

### Protection of Native Riparian Vegetation

Where existing remnant vegetation is located along a waterway and will contribute to improving connections within the landscape.

South East Local Land Services have an expectation that funding provided will meet up to 50% of the total cost of the project, to a maximum of \$15,000 per property.

### Eligibility Criteria:

Landholders must meet all of the following criteria:

- Own or manage this property, located within or adjacent to one of the four target areas in the vicinity of Braidwood, Burra, Michelago or Delegate;
- Be willing to enter into a minimum 10 year management agreement with South East Local Land Services;
- Any on-ground works previously funded by South East Local Land Services (or Catchment Management Authorities) are completed or have not previously received funds from these organisations;
- Agree to 50/50 cost sharing arrangement with South East Local Land Services for the project costs, up to a limit of \$15,000 investment from South East Local Land Services.
- Be proposing activities that meet the criteria set within the landholder guidelines.
